"Hello Friends! For the last few months, this old codger has been lap swimming at a very old and charming natatorium at a nearby university. Every time I hit the water, I think of Sam Reid. Many of you old Westsiders will remember Sam swimming across Cowells' Cove and disappear out past Indicator and Inside Curl and beyond. Sam had a beautiful and unique style of the crawl stroke. He would churn and churn, slowly and steadily. I can still see his white swim cap. I can still "hear" the sound of his hands and wrists as they gently but firmly slapped down in the ocean as he propelled his body through the sea. On many days, he would stand on the point at Point Surf and encourage surfers with his call, "Ouutsiiide." He is missed by many. Godspeed, Sam. My haps are always in your honor."

This is a photo of **Sam Reid** in 1949 on main Santa Cruz Beach in front of the Casino. He was a beach lifeguard at this time. He was also a past Hawaiian Champion surfer in 1928 and 1932, which was equivalent to the world championship today.
